

Corporate Compliance

Juneau Youth Services is committed to a strong system of compliance to all required regulations and laws surrounding the operation of the organization.

Juneau Youth Services maintains a Corporate Compliance Program in accordance with guidelines issued by the federal Department of Health and Human Services, Office of the Inspector General. The Corporate Compliance Program has two primary purposes:

- To ensure that our procedures and practices for billing and clinical documentation conform with federal, state and private payer requirements for health care services; and
- To have a system in place to detect and resolve instances of conduct that do not conform with federal, state and private payer requirements.

The general philosophy of Juneau Youth Services is that successful corporate compliance is directly linked to the code of conduct associated with our organization culture. Our organizational culture promotes teamwork, honest communications, a commitment to legal and ethical conduct, and a strong emphasis on performance and quality improvement. All Juneau Youth Services employees, and contractors or agents that provide client support services, must commit to the Corporate Compliance Code of Conduct.
